

B.E.A.T.S. Program

Youth 10-15 years of age with a diagnosed learning disability or ADHD who are or will be using adaptive technology at school

Description: Participants will increase their keyboarding skills, understand how to use the Internet and software programs or apps to assist with school work completion, understand how to use and apply adaptive technology (text-to-voice, voice-to-text, word prediction, and mind mapping) in the classroom, and understand how to avoid cyber bullying. This interactive program will help develop skills through games, activities, and projects. Participants will be able to use a laptop, iPad, or Chromebook (based on what they have or will be assigned by their school).

Program Fee: \$150 for non-LDA members per 7-week session
\$100 for LDA members per 7-week session.
